9. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

9.1 Races will be sailed under the SVYC Sailing Instructions.

5.3 The Class flag will be Numeral 9 (No. 9)  . Races will be started in accordance with RRS 26.

10. VENUE

11. COURSES

11.1 All races will start from either a Committee Vessel Starting Line and will finish on a Committee Vessel Finishing Line or the Club's fixed Line.

11.2 The Courses will be announced on the night.

12. PENALTY SYSTEM

12.1 The Two-Turn Penalty is replaced by a One-Turn Penalty this changes rule 44.1.

12.2 The committee vessel and support vessels will be given the authority to settle disputes on the water.

12.3 A protest committee will be assembled if required.

13. SCORING

13.1 The Low Point Scoring System (RRS Appendix A) will apply.

14. SUPPORT BOATS

14.1 Support Vessels will be RIBs belonging to Sea View Yacht Club.

16. HAULING -OUT RESTRICTIONS

18. RADIO COMMUNICATION

18.1 Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones. Mermaids use Channel 77 for all race information.

19. PRIZES

19.1 Prizes will be presented at a prize giving at the SVYC After sailing on Tuesday 27th June.

20. DISCLAIMER

20.1 The decision not to go afloat due to weather is at the discretion of the Race Officer, however if the Race Officer deems it safe to go afloat any Sailor who feels the conditions are beyond their capabilities should be allowed to stay ashore.

20.2 In the event of poor weather the racing rules may be adapted. In this case every effort shall be made to ensure all participants are aware.

20.3 At the Race Officers discretion all participants may be asked to reef their dinghies. In this case, any participant ignoring the ruling will be disqualified.

21. INSURANCE

21.1 All boats are insured through Sea View Yacht Club.
